If you are requiring full livery for just 5 days a week your hay and bedding needs are included for the full 7 days as standard.

Extra monthly charges on your bill:

- Each month we currently charge our liveries £3.00 a month for use of our hacking track which circumvents the Cross Country Course. The track is all weather and the charge contributes to it's upkeep.
- We stock the livery tack room with tea, coffee and snacks each month for our liveries to enjoy. We charge £1.00 per month as a contribution to this.
- If you book one of the arenas for exclusive use ie. for a lesson or saddle fitting, the booking fee will be added to your next monthly bill. (Bookings are made by the Leyland Court App by using a discount code). If you have someone offsite come to ride your horse you will need to book the arena for exclusive use and the rider will need to show evidence of their own insurance upon request. If the rider is riding your horse around the track instead of the arena a £5.00 charge is added. If the rider is going to be helping you regularly with your horse and is not charging for a service please ask for a sharers contract for them. No more than 2 sharers per horse.

What do I need to provide?

We will care for your horse in your absence as if they are our own, therefore we advise all our full liveries to ensure that their horse has everything they may need onsite ready for us to use for their care. Ideally all your equipment should be labelled clearly for easy identification and stored only in the storage area provided for your horse.

Essentials

Rugs - the rugs that your horse may require at that time of year should be stored on site. Any surplus should be stored at your home.

Feed Bins - Vermin proof feed bins for hard feed.

Feed Buckets - We recommend a minimum of 2 and that they are labelled.

Haynets - We recommend a minimum of 2 and that they are labelled.

Water Buckets - Although our stables have drinkers, water buckets on site are essential in case of issues with the supply to the drinker e.g a leak or frozen pipes.

Recommended

Horse First Aid Kit - Strongly recommended as immediate treatment for mild injuries.

Spare Head Collar - In case of breakages.

Rubber Matting for Stable - Stables do not include matting as standard, we strongly recommend matting is used to lower the risk of injury.

Hoofpick - We recommend a hoofpick is kept outside your stable at all times as your horse's feet must be picked out each time they leave the stable.

When you join the yard...

When you and your horse join our yard you will be added to the below:

- Whatsapp or FB group with the yard manager, livery groom, horse owner and horse sharer if applicable. This is for day to day communication. Requests to keep horse in when you are planning to ride, notice of farrier/vet visits etc. and any other day to day issues are kept on here.
- Livery Live App. We will add your horse to our yard on Livery Live. This can be used by the owner to store all the horse's information, including feed

required, dates for vaccinations, farrier etc. It can be also used by the owner to make requests such as for clipping, use of hot wash at a certain time etc.

- Leyland Court App. You will be given a discount code that will make it possible for you to book our arenas for your lessons etc. The booking will be added to your next months invoice.
- The Leyland Facebook Livery Chat. This is a chat used by all our liveries to communicate and organise clinics, saddle fitting visits, vet visits etc. as well as share general info. We will also post yard wide notices on this chat occasionally. We have a zero tolerance policy on this chat for any negative or inflammatory posts, anyone causing issues will be blocked immediately.

You can message Katie directly if you have any concerns at all which pertains to the yard. We have an open door policy and take any issues that arise seriously. That said we are there to care for the horses and their welfare is our main concern. We will not get involved in personal issues, disagreements among liveries or private issues unless they effect the yard as a whole. Any issues among liveries must be dealt with by the effected parties, and if any of these issues effect the yard in anyway the relevant parties will be asked to leave.
